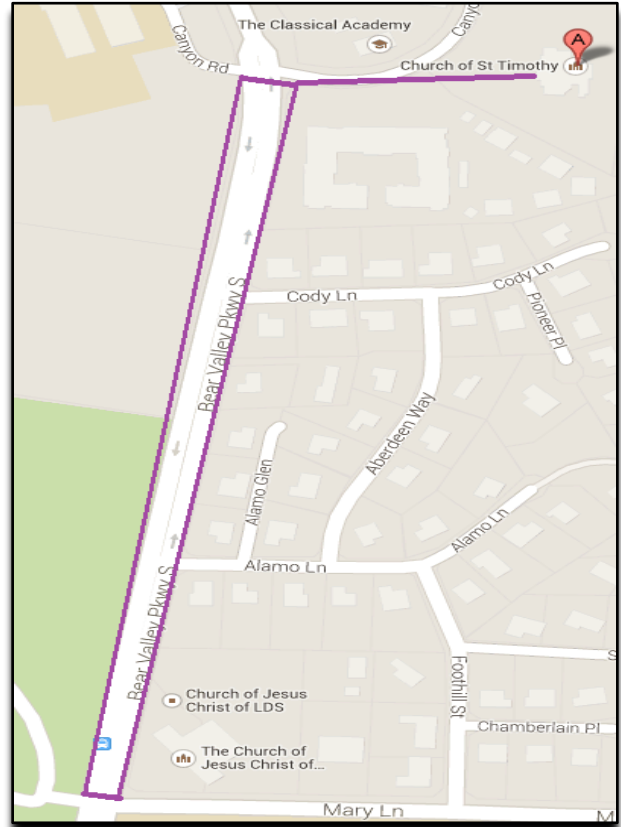
Lamb of God Maternity Home

They will be able to carry their baby to term, treated with dignity, love, and respect for their decision to place it in the loving arms of a forever family. There will be a curriculum in place, designed to help them work on their educational, vocational, and spiritual goals. They will also be taught life skills, such as financial literacy, cooking, sewing, gardening and outdoor activities. They will receive spiritual direction and counseling and the result will be pride in their decision to choose what is best for their baby; to be raised in a family by both a father and mother.
